Welcome to Jeepapalooza 2020. The past six years have been a tremendous success due to the hard work of the volunteers and the patience and understanding of the participants. Previous years have seen us increasing the number of participants exponentially. Due to the requirements of the Comox Valley Regional District, any event with over 400 participants, including volunteers, require permits event insurance and a bunch of other hurdles which added to the workload of the volunteers and incurred significant costs which came out of the funds raised by all the participants.

This year we will not be doing registrations the same way as previous years so please read and follow the registration instructions. We will not be cutting off registrations when we hit a certain number of vehicle registrations but rather, we will be cutting registrations off when we hit the maximum number of participants which is 400.

Cost

The cost for this year's event will be \$100.00 for the vehicle and driver. Additional participants will be \$10.00 per person for those over 12. Any participant under 12 will be free. There will be a \$100.00 fee to transfer a registration from one group to another (until May 1st, 2020). After initial registration there will be a \$10.00 fee to change participants regardless of age. There are no other camping fees or for bringing additional tow vehicles/trailers or travel trailers etc. Removing participants who are unable to attend is free. If any participants removed from the registration want back on the registration list, they will be charged \$10.00 if there is space available.

Registrations

Anyone on site may be asked to provide valid identification. Parents/legal guardians must be able to provide identification for those under 18 if requested. If you are unable to use the form fill please ensure you print clearly and a clear scan is sent via email. If neither of these options work please email the required information and a form will be filled out on your behalf (please ensure all information is there). Any forms not fully complete or readable will not be accepted. Registrations will be on a first come/first serve basis and will be based on the receipt time of the email. Delays between service providers will not be the responsibility of the organizers. The time for incomplete registration will be taken when the registration form or full required information is received. The most common problem for not being able to fill out the form is because it is in an active web browser vice being downloaded. YOU MAY NEED TO DOWNLOAD THE FORM.

1. Participant Information – Please clearly print or fill out first and last name of the primary driver of the vehicle being wheeled. The primary driver must be 18 or older. Any drivers under the age of 18 will require someone 18 and over to register on their behalf. Please fill out a valid email address. Email will be our primary means of correspondence. Phone numbers will only be used to contact you if there is a time sensitive matter.

- 2. Additional Participants Please fill out complete first and last names and check which age group each participant falls into. This will be their age as of the 15th of May. Each member must sign a waiver to participate in the event. Those under 18 will require a participant over 18 to sign as a parent or legal guardian. The maximum number of participants will be equal to the maximum number of properly installed seats and seat belts in the vehicle being wheeled. Only registered participants will be allowed at the event site. Anyone not registered may be asked to leave the premises. To maximize attendance we ask everyone who is not able to make the event to cancel as soon as possible so anyone on a waitlist will have the opportunity to attend.
- 3. Please fill out vehicle make and model. Vehicle plate number can be any legal plate for the road or an off-road plate. All vehicles whether road legal or off-road use only must have valid registration and insurance and cannot expire at any point during the event. Organizers will turn away any vehicle and its participants to registered or insured. Number of seats and seat belts which are factory or properly installed in the vehicle. If the number of participants arriving at the gate exceeds the number of properly installed seats and seat belts, they will be refused entry. No side by sides, quads motorbikes etc will be permitted at the event.
- **4.** To assist the organizers in planning and making trail runs as smooth as possible please check where you believe your skill level is and what level trails you intend to run during the event. Registration sheets for actual runs and vehicle requirements for each run will be available at the event site after 6pm.
- **5.** Again, to assist the organizers in expediting entry please indicate whether you plan to camp onsite and whether you are intending to use a tent or travel trailer under or over 25'.

Saving Adobe Forms

For those who are having trouble saving the form, the best way to save it on computers and mobile devices is to select "print" then change the printer to "Adobe PDF" or "PDF" your device will take you through the steps of saving the form just like any other document. You will then be able to attach the form in an email.

Payments

You do not need to send payment with your registration form. When registration forms are received your payment will be calculated and you will be notified by email of your payment options (etransfer and PayPal). Once payment notification is sent you will have 10 days to complete payment, or your reservation will be forfeited.
